For use in hospital, barn, food processing and institutional/industrial settings.

Intended for use on hard, non-porous surfaces such as plastics, metals, and other composite materials.

For cleaning, disinfecting and sanitizing hard surfaces such as equipment, floors, walls, countertops. Avoid contact with food:

1. For heavily soiled surface, a pre-cleaning step is required.
2. Dilute Novus by adding 200 mL of product to 19.8 L of water (0.5% solution) and apply with mop, cloth, sponge or trigger spray to surface.
3. Allow surface to remain wet for at least 10 minutes.
4. Wipe or allow to air dry

For hard surfaces and/or objects that may come into direct contact with children at the mouthing stage of development, a rinse with potable water is recommended.

For hard surfaces and/or objects that may come into direct contact with food, a rinse with potable water is recommended.

This product is not to be used as a sterilant/high-level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that: (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to pre-clean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high-level disinfection.

Use in animal housing areas (e.g., floors, walls, cages, and animal equipment) within industrial/institutional and barn premises (e.g., farms, poultry plants, veterinary clinics, and kennels). Remove all animals/poultry and their feed from premises prior to disinfection.

Remove all heavy soil, such as urine and fecal matter, from hard surfaces and objects prior to disinfection. Empty all feeding and watering appliances prior to disinfection. Following disinfection, do not house animals/poultry until areas have been ventilated. All surfaces and/or objects that will contact feed or drinking water should be rinsed with potable water before reuse.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

DANGER: May intensify fire; oxidizer. Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. May cause respiratory irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames and other ignition sources. No smoking. Keep away from clothing and other combustible materials. Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, eye protection and face protection. Do not breathe mist or vapour. Wash thoroughly after handling. Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product.

FIRST AID:

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Flush with cool water. Wash with soap and water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and DIN with you when seeking medical attention.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD, OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.

STORAGE

Store at room temperature locked up. Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep container tightly closed.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available.

Triple rinse container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.
